A new landmark at 3,020 metres: The Titlis Tower.

At 3,020 m (9,908 ft) above sea level Titlis is the highest excursion mountain in Central Switzerland and a destination beloved by guests from around the world. Famous for the Titlis Rotair – the world's first revolving cable car – as well as the Glacier Cave and the thrilling Cliff Walk suspension bridge, Titlis has long been a symbol of alpine adventure and innovation.

In May 2026, Titlis will unveil its newest attraction: the Titlis Tower. Designed by the renowned architectural firm Herzog & de Meuron, the tower transforms a former infrastructure building into a world-class mountain destination. At its heart is a stylish restaurant and bar, offering Casual Fine Dining in collaboration with internationally acclaimed culinary advisor Dietmar Sawyere. Above, the Horizon Deck provides a breathtaking 360-degree view over the surrounding high-alpine landscape, making it an unforgettable experience for every visitor.

By 2029, the Titlis Peak Station will be fully renewed, featuring modern restaurants, shops, and a welcoming and spacious arrival area – enhancing the already popular destination of Titlis and making the alpine experience even more memorable.
